At SSE, bridge courses of 2 - 3.5 hours on Statistics for Economics and Foundation of Mathematics are conducted for first year students At SIDTM, two courses on Telecom bridge and Finance bridge are conducted. Telecom bridge course is for non-technical students to understand technology. Finance bridge course is mainly for engineering and non-finance students to understand financial topics. There are total 10 sessions of 1.5 hours duration.
