NAAC has revised the AQAR format reporting format. The revised one is more focused on Quantitative metrics and evidence based. The format is similar to SSR format of NAAC.

Methodology that shall be adopted by the QMB department. With the help of the QIC and QIC coordinators of the constituents, data generation and data collation would be done in line with AQAR template. Before initiation of same QMB dept. shall handhold and facilitate QIC's in identifying and authenticating data generation sources.

AQAR audit will be done to verify and authenticate the data.

SIDTM, Pune A brief presentation was made by Director, SIDTM –Pune and briefed members on the Quality initiatives adopted.

Holistic Development Faculty

- Based on the 20:1 ratio, the number of faculty members is 15;
- Out of these faculty members, 11 faculty members are Ph.D. and the rest 4 are pursuing Ph.D.

Continuous Quality Improvement

- 2017: Introduced a new specialization "Analytics and Finance"
- 2018: Introduced specialization allocation test & psychometric test
- 2018: Started offering electives within the specialization
- 2018: Flipped classroom (Streaming and I Spring) and introduction of video, and online
- 2018: Introduced case study project in the telecom business.
