

Dr. Raman informed the members about the implementation of Palo Alto firewalls to protect the university from cyber-attacks. He also mentioned that the IT department is training staff on these next-generation firewalls.

Additionally, he briefed the members on the ongoing revamp of the university's website, aimed at improving its visibility and achieving a position among the top 100 university websites by January 2025.

Mr. Harshad Gune, Head of Software Development at SIU, provided an overview of the Software Development Department and its functions. Mentioned below are the key activities and accomplishments of the Software Development Department.

Moodle Management:

- Managing over 41 Moodle instances.
- · Initial six months focused on infrastructure management, deployment, and training.
- Recent six months involved customizing modules for institutions, including:
 - o Attendance management.
 - o Lecture cancellations.
 - o Faculty lecture counts.
 - Student attendance exemptions.
- · Developed a comprehensive attendance module.

Feedback System Implementation:

- Devised a comprehensive feedback mechanism in consultation with Dr. Dharmendra Pandey.
- Capturing feedback from all institutions.
- · Analysis of feedback is in progress.

- Implemented across all postgraduate and undergraduate programs, except at the new Hyderabad campus.
- Used for various academic aspects including:
 - o Creation of timetables.
 - o Capturing attendance.
 - Sharing files.
 - Uploading content required for academic delivery.
 - Feedback collection.

The department continues to innovate and support institutional needs with robust software solutions, ensuring efficient and seamless academic and administrative processes by migrating to AlmaLinux and upgrading Moodle to version 4.3.

Following Dr. Hardik's advice, starting from July - August, a newsletter will be released to guide faculty on new Moodle features and how they can enhance their teaching and learning to improve Moodle adoption.

After discussing Moodle implementation, Dr. Dharmendra Pandey elaborated on the key areas that the QMB focuses on. These areas are centered around delivering internal-level outcome-based Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) for the QMB staff. The focus areas, which are all interlinked, include:

- · Accreditations and ranking
- · Benchmarking and standardization
- Data analysis and strategic input
- · Compliance and monitoring
- Process improvement
- Support and Engagement

Adding to this, QMB has its unique Quality initiatives including;

- 1. Development of Symbiosis Accreditation Framework (SAF):
- The SAF is SIU's internal accreditation system which includes comprehensive standards, indicators, metrics, and evidence requirements for evaluating SIU's institutes.
- o It includes grading schemes based on the defined metric
- 2. Global Benchmarking of SIU's Sustainability Policy:
- QMB has conducted a benchmarking exercise to compare SIU's sustainability policy with leading universities worldwide.
- This exercise aims to identify best practices and areas for potential improvement in SIU's sustainability initiatives.
- 3. SIU Ranking Analysis:
- SIU's ranking performance was analyzed based on THE, NIRF, and QS and benchmarked against top-ranked universities, and recommendations were provided to the management to enhance SIU's rankings.
- 4. Three-Year AQAR Analysis:
- o QMB has thoroughly analyzed SIU's AQAR for the last three years.
- A detailed report highlighting key findings and recommendations has been submitted to the management.
- 5. Benchmarking Audit Processes at SIU:
- The academic and administrative audit processes at SIU have been benchmarked by QMB, and the recommendations submitted to the Registrar's Office and the Director of Academics.

ITEM NO.4

To discuss about the NEP-related aspects and academic developments at SIU.

Dr. Asmita Dani, Director Academics, delivered a comprehensive presentation on NEP-related initiatives and academic advancements, focusing on current achievements and future strategies at SIU. The strengths of the new academic program, including cross-disciplinary and multidisciplinary approaches, technology integration, and flexibility for students was highlighted too.

The key discussions encompassed the effective implementation of NEP 2020, the launch of a 4-year Undergraduate Degree Program, interdisciplinary programs, the introduction of new courses, the reorganization of existing program frameworks, the Academic Bank of Credits, the integration of the Indian Knowledge System, a focus on sustainability, and the adoption of Outcome Based Education.

Dr. Asmita also provided a brief overview of Outcome-Based Education (OBE), emphasizing that the Academic Department at SIU is leading efforts to update its policies and practices. A committee comprising representatives from all faculties has been formed to conduct a thorough review. Aligning SIU's policies with NBA guidelines has been a key focus, as highlighted during visits by NBA, NAAC, and academic audit teams. Furthermore, collaboration with the IT committee is underway to select software capable of accurately calculating attainment levels for Course Outcomes (CO) and Program Outcomes (PO).

Overall, the NEP and its implementation in universities, highlighting challenges and opportunities were discussed in the IQAC meeting.
