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#### To update members about AQAR and OMPI audit 2016-2017.

Members were briefed on the AQAR and OMPI audit which was successfully conducted from 9<sup>th</sup> August to 12<sup>th</sup> August 2017 at constituents of SIU.

Members were further briefed that a Pre-audit training was conducted on 28-07-2017 to train the auditors and after the audit, feedback was taken from the auditors on the documentation and authenticity of data submitted by the institute in Online AQAR & OMPI portals. The feedback was consolidated and forwarded to respective criterion heads for necessary actions.

#### Item No. 4

#### To consider the draft AQAR 2016-2017 and recommend it to BOM.

IQAC Head gave a presentation on Highlights of draft AQAR 2016-20. Also presented a comparative analysis of AQAR 2016-2017 with 2015-16. One of the members suggested increasing publications rather than participation in conferences. It was also suggested that there is a scope for Inter institute research so institutes can collaboratively do research.

Draft AQAR was presented before the members and it was recommended to BOM.

#### Item No. 5

### To brief members about revised NAAC guidelines.

Members were briefed about the revised guidelines received from NAAC w.e.f July 2017 which says that the assessment process will be carried out in three stages and will comprise three main components, viz., Self-Study Report (SSR) - Quantitative & Qualitative questions, Student Satisfaction Survey, and the Peer Team Report. The SSR has two kinds of Metrics: one, those requiring quantifiable facts and figures as data which have been indicated as 'quantitative metrics' (QnM); and two, those metrics requiring descriptive responses and are accordingly named 'qualitative metrics' (QlM).



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Members noted the new guidelines.

Resolution Item No.5: IQAC: 09.10.2017

Resolved that the revised guidelines of NAAC were noted by the members.

#### Item No. 6

To note the Summary of Management Information System (MIS)/Faculty Information System (FIS) Workshop feedback.

Feedback given by faculty members regarding FIS and MIS was shared with the IQAC members. The following points were shared.

MIS/FIS training was conducted from 29-06-2017 to 05-07-2017 including training for off-campuses via video conferencing. The meeting was aimed to sort out issues coming in the online software, as well as changes, which were incorporated as per the inputs received from faculty members.

#### ITEM NO. 10

To inform the members regarding the establishment of the new Institutes & departments in the University in the A.Y. 2017-2018.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor gave a brief description of the collaborative initiatives in the University for student and faculty exchange programs and joint research.

SCBS- Symbiosis Centre for Behavioral Studies: SCBC has been established to intensify the thrust of behavioral research scholarship within Symbiosis International (Deemed University). Often associated



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with management studies and social sciences, behavioral science explores the activities and interactions among human beings. Studies in behavioral sciences include investigation and analysis of individual or human relationships through behavioral aspects. The centre is multi-disciplinary and encourages behavioral research from the various faculty within the university. The infrastructure at SCBS is equipped with state-of-the-art hardware and contemporary software to facilitate modern scientific research.

SCNN -Symbiosis Centre for Nanoscience and nanotechnology: In order to promote basic and applied research in the fields of nanoscience and nanotechnology, Symbiosis International (Deemed University) established a Centre for Nanoscience and Nanotechnology (SCNN) that could ultimately innovate and develop new-generation materials/devices for societal benefits.

The aim is to develop a global network for research and innovation and provide leadership in developing affordable smart-technology.
