Guidelines for Identification of Good Quality Research Conferences: A research/academic conference is the meeting of researchers of a discipline, in which the researchers present their latest work, share specific findings, discuss the problems, disseminate the latest research happening and get direction for taking their work forward to contribute to further evolution of the discipline.

The purpose of research conferences is to disseminate information about state-of-the-art research in a discipline.

It is an assembly of researchers and academics that present and share the latest work, discuss the implications, create new research agendas or refine the existing ones and set the directions for further research in the field.

Guidelines for Major Research Projects: Symbiosis International (Deemed University) strives to promote teaching and research in emerging and identified thrust areas. The University invites research proposals for major research projects under the Symbiosis Institute of Research & Innovation from existing Faculties. Its main aim is to institutionalize research activities and promote excellence in research by providing financial support to individual researchers.
