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#### ITEM NO. 1

#### ITEM NO. 2

To discuss Quality Initiatives adopted at Institutes for the A.Y. 2016-2017

The following points were discussed for Quality Initiatives adopted at Institutes during the A.Y 2016-2017.

1. Curriculum Development

The University and its constituents follow a planned, purposeful, and systematic process of enriching the curriculum. The quality improvement strategies adopted by the University and its constituents include the following:

- Periodic review of the curriculum
- Curriculum review workshops are conducted.
- Capsule Courses on contemporary issues and Seminars have been conducted
- Academic audit is conducted after the end of every semester to evaluate the teaching and learning practices.

#### 2. Teaching and Learning

The University and its constituents lay thrust on effective teaching to achieve the desired learning outcomes.

During the year various initiatives have been undertaken to enhance teaching and learning outcomes.

- All the programs offered have well-defined objectives.
- A detailed lesson plan for each course is shared with the students at the beginning of the semester.
- A dedicated Assurance of Learning Team (AOL) looks into the development of learning goals and traits. Evaluation of each subject is linked with measuring the traits.
- The syllabus of each course is provided to students before the beginning of the semester which includes the learning goals and traits.

Members discussed the need for having more senior faculty on board, so as to enhance teaching and learning, and research activities and to nurture junior faculty. The Vice-Chancellor mentioned that this was difficult in certain domains like Law, Design, and Media.
