ITEM NO.1


To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 20th May 2015.

ITEM NO.3


To discuss the plan of action for the Academic year 2015-2016.

- 4. To set up an incubation cell for Entrepreneurs.
- 5. To improvise examination software to help automate a few more processes such as creating BOE subcommittee format, Term end assessment letters, and Revaluation letters.
- 6. To revise some of the questions in the OMPI questionnaire.
- 7. To improve the Academic Audit process of SIU programs.

One of the members suggested conducting an IQAC audit at the end of every semester which will improve the quality of the academic and administrative processes of SIU.


Resolution Item No.6: IQAC: 28.08.2015


Resolved that the information regarding the 'Gender Sensitization' policy is hereby noted by the members.


